Targeted Assistance Program (2017-18 & 2018-19)	Student identification is used to determine students who are eligible for academic services. Student services <u>ARE NOT</u> based on socio-economic status.	Program targets resources only to	Professional development with Title I funds focuses on staff who provide direct support to targeted students. Teachers who are working with targeted students must be highly qualified.	Parents must be notified of students' eligibility for Title I services. Parents of targeted students only are eligible to participate in Family Engagement Events.
Schoolwide Program	Program promotes improved instruction for all students and constitutes comprehensive school reform.	All students are eligible for additional services. Students identified as most at-risk are provided additional supports.	Title I funds are used to provide professional development for all staff to support all students. All classroom teachers, teachers of the arts (music/art), and paraprofessionals, must be highly qualified.	No parent notification of additional services to students is necessary. All parents are eligible to participate in Parent and Family Engagement Events.
Schoolwide AND Targeted Programs	Develop evidence-based programs to ensure all students have an opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach proficiency on state academic achievement standards and assessments. On-going monitoring of student progress is necessary to determine program modifications.	Students are to be pulled from core instruction as little as possible. Before school, after school, and summer classes may be considered.	Title I funds are used to support instruction with approved supplemental positions (i.e., resource teachers).	Emphasis is placed on family engagement and building family capacity. Home-School Compact and Family Engagement plans must be developed with stakeholder input.
